

Final phase of IMAILE PCP has started - two remaining suppliers

After the first two phases in the selection process of IMAILE Pre-Commercial Procurement **two awarded solutions** started into the final phase in January 2017 when the suppliers are still performing research & development activities.



3 PCP stages with one framework contract:

- Phase 1: Solution Design (completed)
 380 000 EUR (up to 8 suppliers funded, duration of 3 months)
- Phase 2: Prototype Development (completed)
 1 520 000 EUR (up to 4 suppliers funded, duration of 6 months)
- Phase 3: Pre-Commercial small scale product/service development (ongoing)
 1 900 000 EUR (up to 2 suppliers funded, duration of 7 months)
